AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE

Denton Independent School District AND TEA Grow Your Own Grant Program Cycle 2 Pathway 1 Participants

This Agreement is entered into this day, by Denton Independent School District, a public school organized, and existing under the laws of the state of Texas, hereinafter called "DISTRICT" and TEA GYO Grant Program Cycle 2 Pathway 1 Teacher Participants, hereinafter referred to as "PARTICIPANT." In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 TERM OF AGREEMENT

- 1. This Agreement shall commence on approval of the PARTICIPANTS by the Office of the Superintendent and terminate three years from the effective date of this agreement, or prior to that date should either party give written notice of termination in accordance with Article I, Section 2 herein.
- 2. Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason by giving the other party at least ninety (90) days written notice.

ARTICLE 11 DISTRICT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The DISTRICT will identify PARTICIPANTS who have met the requirements to participate in the program

- under the directives of the grant.
- 2. The DISTRICT will comply with the grant guidelines including all state reporting processes.
- 3. The DISTRICT will support the PARTICIPANTS at the campus and central administration levels.

ARTICLE 111

PARTICIPANT RESPONSBILITIES

- 1. The PARTICIPANT must hold a standard or life teacher certificate in the State of Texas.
- 2. The PARTICIPANT must currently be employed as a teacher.
- 3. The PARTICIPANT must show measureable evidence of student achievement within a diverse student population.

ARTICLE IV

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The DISTRICT will expect the PARTICIPANTS to commit at least two years of employment with the DISTRICT under this Agreement beginning with the 2019-20 school year.

ARTICLE VI ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement supersedes all previous oral and written agreements and constitutes the entire agreement related to the subject contained herein between the DISTRICT and the PARTICIPANTS and may only be amended by mutual written consent of both parties.

GOVERNING LAW/LEGAL CONSTRUCTION

The laws of the Texas shall govern the validity of this Agreement and any of its terms or provisions, as well as the rights and duties of the parties.
