RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS EQUIPMENT SALE

WHEREAS, Board Policy DN states “The superintendent may dispose of all obsolete, surplus, unwanted and/or excessively damaged equipment and supplies owned by the district in accordance with the following procedures:

1. The Board will pass a resolution declaring property with a value of greater than \$500 as surplus;

2. Items estimated by the deputy clerk to have a value of less than \$500 may be sold by the deputy clerk at prices estimated to be the market values of the items. All sales by the deputy clerk will be recorded by item, price and buyer;

3. Property or materials estimated by the deputy clerk to be greater than \$500 may be declared surplus and may be sold by the deputy clerk through a bidding procedure. If public sales fail to produce any interested buyers or bidders, remaining unsold materials may then, at the superintendent’s discretion, be disposed of as scrap or junk or be donated to appropriate charitable or educational agencies.

WHEREAS, the following item has a value greater than \$500, is declared surplus, and will be sold in accordance with procedure:

Item Description	Location	Reason
Welder - LNC PRECISION TIG 275 - HEPPNER purchased in 2015-16	Heppner Jr/SR High School	Electrical power supply is inadequate at this facility.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Morrow County School District Board directs administration to proceed with the sale of surplus equipment.
