

MEETING DATE: September 21, 2015

AGENDA ITEM: Consider an exception to FDA (LOCAL) – Admission: Interdistrict Transfers.

PRESENTER: Derek Citty, Superintendent

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): #2. The District shall maintain a safe and orderly environment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Recently the Parker County Appraisal District implemented a new software package that provided for a more accurate accounting of District boundary lines. It was discovered in the process of more clearly identifying these boundary lines that, in one location, the boundary between Aledo ISD and Weatherford ISD was misaligned to the east. The new alignment has left three known AISD students now to be wholly within the bounds of Weatherford ISD. These students are all enrolled in our secondary campuses and have been students of Aledo ISD since Kindergarten.

Under the guidelines as set forth in FDA (LOCAL) these students no longer have the right to attend AISD schools.

Trustees should know that while gathering information related to this item and considering the best interests of these students, the Superintendent has allowed them to continue enrollment until Trustees have an opportunity to review this request.

A copy of FDA (LOCAL) is included for Trustees review.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION(S): Given that this error impacts only three known students and since these students have been continuously enrolled since Kindergarten in Aledo ISD, Administration believes it is in the best interest of these students to stay so long as they continue to be enrolled in AISD.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no known impact to the 2015-16 budget related to this item.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMENDATION: Administration recommends Trustees allow the exception to FDA (LOCAL) to continue for the students affected by the shift of the District boundary between Aledo ISD and Weatherford ISD.
