Tennis:

Boys single and a mixed double won district to advance to regionals. Other medalists at district included boys doubles and one boys singles.

Boys Track:

Boys participation numbers were great this year. 39 total athletes competed. Our coaching staff does a great job of sharing athletes. Varsity boys won the Lindsay meet, finished 2nd at Muenster, 3rd at the Bob Grundy Invitational. We had 11 boys advance in 12 different events to Area, 7 events at Regionals, and 2 events at State. New School Records in the 4x200 Relay 1:33.08, High Jump 6'8", 110H 15.39, 1600 4:42.8.

Girls Track:

5 girls advanced in 9 different events to area, 6 events at regionals, 2 events at state. New School Records in the 4x100 Relay 49.49 and 200 25.09.

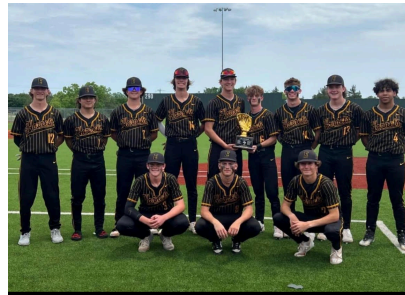


Successful Events/News/Stories to Report
