Reasons for Weather-Related Closures

(Decisions Supported by NWS Twin Cities)

Unsafe road conditions caused by ice/snow (timing vs. snow totals)

Extreme wind chills (Typically -35 degrees F) for an extended period

Actual air temp of -25 degrees F for a sustained period



MN Requirements for Instructional Days & Hours

MN State Statute 120A.41

Minimum of 165 Instructional Days AND 1020 Hours (Secondary)

E-Learning vs Traditional 'Snow Days'

School funding is tied to instructional days/hours

MN allows up to five e-Learning days for weather-related events per year

622 Calendar only 6 hours above state minimum (Grades 7, 8, 10, 11, 12)

622 can only have two traditional 'snow days' before shifting to e-Learning days



Options for Districts to Make Up Instructional Time

Convert remaining non-student days into regular school days (for example: teacher planning days or Spring Break days)

Extend the length of remaining school days

Add days onto the end of the school year
