

STRENGTHS

- All Students increased from 43.6% to 45% (+1.0%).
- Emergent Bilingual (EB) students are exceeding their target by 2.4%, even with a year-over-year drop.
- Students who receive SPED services are within 0.9% of their annual target.
- The district maintained or improved three out of four indicators compared to the previous year.

AREAS OF OPPORTUNITY

- Hispanic students dropped -6.0%, the largest decline, falling from 42.9% to 37%.
- Black students (17.1% away from target) and Two or More races (15.6% away from target) still need substantial gains despite high performance.
- Students who receive SPED services (24%) and EB (33%) students have the lowest absolute performance rates, indicating a need for targeted instructional and support strategies.
