## Elementary Initiatives

- Quarterly Bravo Breakfast Celebration
- Staff/Student soccer game
- Hallway chains (A link is added for meeting hallway behavior expectations.) The class with the longest chain gets a trophy for the week.
- $100 \%$ of teachers using CAB cards and participating in the Tier 1 processes.
- Lesson plans and explicitly teaching behavioral expectations on the matrix.
- Over $80 \%$ of staff at Loves Park has volunteered to be a CICO mentor.
- Social and Academic groups meet weekly with the school social worker if the student has not met their CICO goal.
- FBA/BIPs completed when students are not successful at Tier 2.
- PBIS data is processed during MTSS (RtI) meetings.
- Students are acknowledged with certificates for successful completion of CICO.
- A fancy lunch table is set up every other Friday for grade level CAB card winners.
- Daily Kindness Counts winners.
- Monthly whole school PBIS drawings from CAB cards not picked for the lunch table.
- Strong Morning Meeting implementation.
- Strong staff example of responsible, respectful, and ready to learn behavior.
- Quarterly celebrations.
- Weekly drawings for positive behavior
- YouTube video to build community
- Ice cream celebration
- Prince Alonzo assembly

- Gave over 140 free Subway sandwiches to teachers to distribute to students who regularly demonstrated Huskie Habits

## HH9 4 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Quarter Initiatives

- Continued PBI S tier 1 initiatives including pride stickers and random reward reinforcers of expected behavior
- Continued top dog initiative with student being nominated by teachers for following the pride matrix
- Utilized discipline data to identify March as peak disciplinary referral month, teachers were proactive in addressing student behavior.
- April/May showed significant increase over previous years in number of disciplinary referrals
- After decrease in percentage of Special Education subgroup receiving referrals saw increase in $4^{\text {th }}$ quarter
- Continue to see increase in percentage of students participating in checkin checkout as well as those responding at the $80 \%$ level.
- Implemented student climate survey
- PBIS Universal team met with students to get perspective of student climate survey results
- End of year PBIS celebration in conjunction with PRIDE card recognition
- Recognized all students who received perfect attendance for the year
- PBIS Tier 1 and Tier 2 teams both met to discuss next year and ways to address students in a proactive manner earlier

- 2 will graduate if successful in summer program for a Grand Total of $26=90 \%$ success
- Total of 25 students from grades: $10^{\text {th }}$ ( 12 students), $11^{\text {th }}$ ( 9 students), and $12^{\text {th }}$ ( 4 students) with perfect attendance for the 2013-14 school year
- Counselors started SAIG
- Student recognition PRIDE Assembly in May 2014
- Ice Cream Social
- Continued with CICO and bi-monthly meetings
- Continued with Pride Store for PBIS incentives and PRIDE sticker exchange
