


# Ensuring high levels of learning for all students



#### Lesson Frame:



### Critical Writing:

**Critical Writing** is writing designed for the specific purpose of *thinking* & *making connections*.

- Daily expectation in all classes except for math
- Weekly expectation in math




#### Frequent Small Group Purposeful Talk (FSGPT) / Academic Discussion:

*Frequent:* Insert FSGPT into lectures, note taking sessions, or other activities where students have been focused longer than their age appropriate attention span.

*Small Group*: Group size (recommendation groups of 2 students) designed to engage ALL students in academic conversations.

**Purposeful:** Intentionally planned seed question or talk topic that will drive the conversation that is designed to increase understanding, promote connections, and/or extend student thinking.



Active Participation:

Creating and implementing an effective learner environment that is **engaging** and **aligned to learner needs**.

## Student Learning

All students remain on-task, responding to frequent opportunities for active engagement throughout the lesson.

Lesson is led by both teacher & students & students productively progress through new learning.

### Instructional Design:

Lesson provides multiple strategies designed to maximize student engagement & contribution is monitored to ensure full participation.


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## ALEDO ISD Problem of Practice 2023-2024




After an analysis of district data, students are not consistently demonstrating essential academic and social behaviors, and there is not consistent implementation of an engaging learner environment that is aligned to learner needs.

- Support teachers in utilizing results from formative processes and tools to strategically adjust instructional pacing, plan differentiated instruction, and monitor progress.
- Develop systems for identifying, modeling, and monitoring essential academic and social behaviors.
- Deepen understanding around the learner engagement rubric in the indicators of: active participation, learning environment, and formative processes and tools.


**Guiding Questions:** What are the essential academic and social behaviors that are expected of students and how do we model and monitor these expectations? What instructional design elements contribute to an effective learner environment? What does student engagement look like, sound like? How can differentiating lesson content, process, and/or product support all learner needs?


