Summary:	The technology consulting firm that worked with Huckabee on our recent construction projects missed including software licenses and storage for new video cameras in the project specifications. The video cameras were installed in the District's schools as part of its surveillance and security program, and the licensing and storage are needed. Huckabee worked with several contractors to competitively acquire the best pricing for these items. The District reviewed the pricing, and it is appropriate and competitive. If the project specifications had included these items, the District would have approved the cost in the construction package. Therefore, the recommendation is to use contingency that is in the construction contract to purchase them as originally planned. The total amount for 22 video cameras is \$36,372. This amount exceeds the administration's approval authority.
