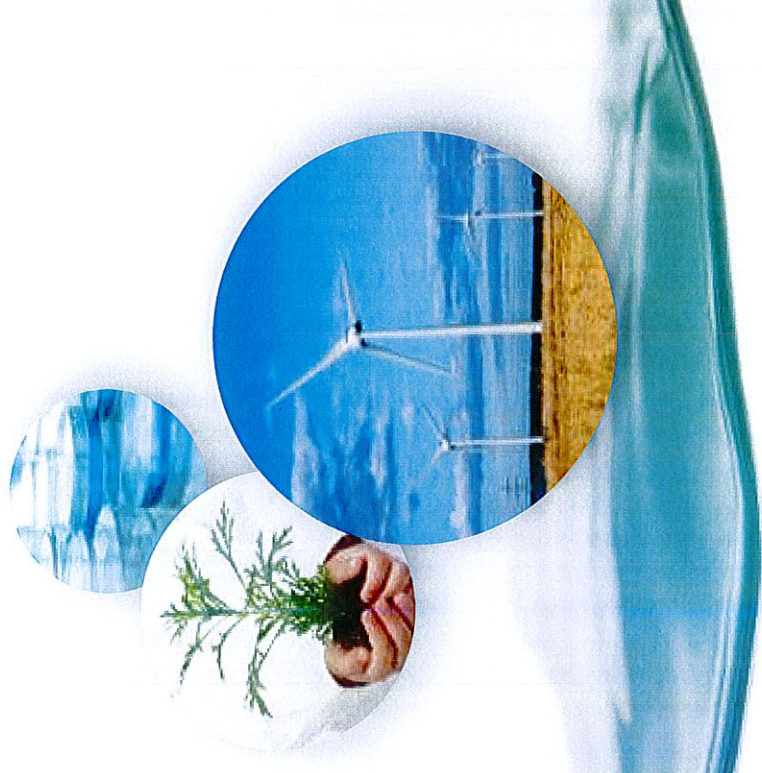
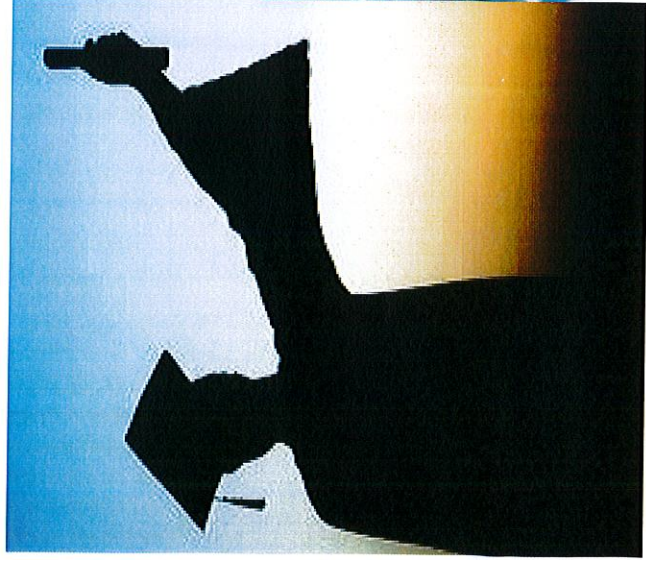

## Issues and Resolutions

- TSI is the qualifying assessment in Reading, Writing and Math that **determines** the percent of students requiring remediation.
- Students who enrolled in independent colleges or universities in Texas, out of state colleges or universities, or any non-public career school **are not included.**
- UISD is now providing **more opportunities** for students to take the TSI exams since we now administer TSI at each high school and at different times during the year.
- TSI prep courses are offered to **assist students prior** to taking the exams.
