It is the position of the Board of Education that the providing of consultative and preventive health services is generally the responsibility of ~~city and~~ county government, and that the treatment of individual children is a parental responsibility. In accordance with this position, the Board of Education expects the school staff to cooperate with the Wayne County Department of Health and other governmental agencies. In addition to cooperating with the Wayne County Department of **Public** Health, it is the policy of the Board of Education to support programs of health education directed to both parents and teachers in regard to student health and to the health of staff members.

## INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM INTRAMURAL ACTIVITIES
