- □ 2006-2007
 - Launched in five elementary campuses, three middle schools, and CHS
 - Middle school & CHS = elective class
 - North and CHS expanded to resource ELA class second semester
 - Offered at secondary summer school
- □ 2007-2008
 - Middle school READ 180 = ELA class
 - Expanded to all secondary resource ELA classes
 - Currently expanding to all elementary campuses
 - Currently expanding to ESL students at West and East

06-07 Takeaways

- READ 180 is delivering significant reading gains in CISD
- □ All 9 schools demonstrated average Lexile gain, with average gain of 24 to 267 Lexiles
- □ 59% to 100% of students within each school have demonstrated average Lexile gains
- Students at Lee, Mockingbird, Pinkerton, Wilson,
 North, West, and CHS have demonstrated growth a full grade level gain* or greater
