Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends approval of the annual Property Tax Appraisal Fees as presented.
Authority for this Action	Board Policy: • CCH(LEGAL): ○ The county appraisal district is responsible for appraising property in the appraisal district for ad valorem tax purposes of each taxing unit in the appraisal district. Each taxing unit participating in the appraisal district is allocated a portion of the amount of the budget equal to the proportion that the total dollar amount of property taxes imposed in the appraisal district by the unit for the tax year in which the budget proposal is prepared bears to the sum of the total dollar amount of property taxes imposed in the district by each participating unit for that year. • CH(LOCAL): ○ The Board delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to make budgeted purchases for goods or services. However, any single, budgeted purchase of goods or services that costs \$50,000 or more, regardless of whether the goods or services are competitively purchased, shall require Board approval before a transaction may take place.
Goal/Objective Addressed	Crosby ISD will be a good steward of taxpayers' money.
Background	The Harris Central Appraisal District is a political subdivision of the State of Texas. The purpose of the appraisal district is to discover and appraise property for ad valorem tax purposes for each taxing unit within the boundaries of the District. Each taxing unit is allocated fees based on the appraisal district's proposed budget. The estimated cost allocation to Crosby ISD is \$307,254.
