5) VIP Service Summaries - VIP Agrees to Provide:

- a. Student and Staff Portraits, and District and School Access to all Photos/Photo Information
 - i) All digital images made available in 48 hours, for use in student information systems and related databases, yearbooks, display within the school, for printed ID cards, and authorized PR purposes
 - ii) **Images accessible on VIP's Client Access Portal**, a user-friendly, secure, proprietary online resource available to any authorized user on any computer
 - (1) **An administrative export** available in 48 hours containing preliminary school picture images linked to data
 - (2) A yearbook export available two-three weeks after last fall retake day containing final yearbook school picture images (consistently cropped, color-corrected for true-to-life skin tones, and of a resolution compatible with school/yearbook publisher's software to meet or exceed industry standards set forth by the PSPA)
 - (3) **Financial and informational reports** such as photographed/not photographed lists, package verification lists, etc. sortable available to authorized users, viewable district-wide as needed
 - (4) **An online calendar** listing past and upcoming photo dates along with appointment details
 - iii) **Staff Downloads** accessible to all staff before retake day and throughout the school year via a link to a Faculty Image list, where staff can choose which image will be used in the yearbook, and download complimentary digital photos with background options
 - iv) **Principal's directory** for easy reference, sorted as requested, downloadable after retake day, and printed books delivered to the school upon request
- b. Staff, Scheduling, and Photo Days
 - Sales representative and account representative, local, experienced, and readily available to with school staff regularly, communicate consistently, and reply in a timely manner not to exceed 24 hours
 - ii) **Photo days and schedules** that will meet the needs of the school and ensure sufficient photography staff, carefully discussed prior to photo day to clarify location, layout, photo day traffic flow, number of photo set-ups (decided by timeframe, student number, ages, and arrival rate), and other data, ID card, and yearbook requirements; ; on average, one school portrait photographer able to photograph approximately 35-50 students per hour, and one sports photographer able to photograph 2 athletes per minute
 - Photographers, extensively trained and guided at each photo day by an experienced lead, communicating clearly and pleasantly with staff and students of all levels and needs, conducting themselves properly in accordance with a school environment, dressed professionally (always wearing VIP clothing and VIP ID), prioritizing school time by arriving punctually, checking in with the school, and

- working efficiently throughout the photo process
- iv) All staff practicing current Covid safety guidelines such as social distancing and health safety practices
- v) **High-quality photos** professionally lit and focused, while important details such as expression, hair, jewelry, clothing/uniforms, and glasses are adjusted by verbal direction
- vi) **Scannable QR code "Photo Passes"** in place of school picture paper order form envelopes to ensure a faster picture day, sorted as requested to be easily distributed before or as students arrive at the camera, by VIP check-in staff, volunteers, or school staff
- vii) **Efficient workflow and pace**, using streamlined systems and equipment to take approximately 45-55 students/staff members photos per hour, or two athletes per minute

d. Customer Service and Delivery

- i) **Customer Support for families**, replying in a timely manner not to exceed 24 hours, available via email and live chat at vipis.com, or at 262.375.4457, Monday-Friday, 8 am 5 pm
- ii) Fast turn-around times and timely delivery (2-3 weeks for most orders) ensured by a local, in-house production facility and high-speed HP Indigo Press, which allows VIP team members to efficiently provide or hand-deliver products as needed
- iii) **Quality photography products, all VIP-produced** in state-of-the-art processing lab, so team members have total control over quality standards and handle every order with urgency and care

- iv) **Prints delivered in exciting booklet format**, which serves as a special, memorable keepsake and includes a cover that prevents damage customized with school logos and colors, three complimentary bonus photos, a calendar, a "student stats" memory page, and click-n-safe/reorder cards, all on environmentally friendly, scratch proof, water-resistant, paper

e. Communication Tools and Services

- i) **Informational text** and digital flyers sent to the school before and after each photo day to post and share in newsletters, via social media, and online
- ii) **Direct Communication Plan**, informing families for you, via email, when "Picture Day is coming", when "Your pictures are ready" with a direct link to a portrait image gallery, as well as additional reminders to order, sent only to those who have not participated, and monthly promotions and incentives such as "free shipping" to increase participation
- iii) **Translated materials** and Spanish speaking staff in office and onsite upon request

f. ID Cards and Systems

- i) **ID Cards** for students/staff as directed by and to meet the standards set forth by the school, printed on durable PVC Plastic, compatible with school softwares (all file formats can match school specifications), custom-designed to be multi-functional (for students and staff, visitors, substitute teachers, and specialty badges), able to include up to 20 fields for each school, icons designating participation in activities (such as athletic passes), back printing options, and bar code fonts compatible with systems such as KRONOS and One Source for school lunch programs), and which can be sorted as needed and delivered before the school year ("roll-over" IDs, using previous year's images), or delivered 10-14 days after photo day (using new images), with black and white "temporary cards" for students without an image to use until a photo is taken
- ii) ID System Portal to securely maintain database and ID images, track IDs, take ID photos, complete necessary fields and data updates to create new cards, and reprint cards (see ID Card Printer) anytime from any computer by any authorized user, on a cloud based software that can be networked to ID printers within the school system, is compatible with Windows systems, installed in Chrome with assistance from a VIP ID representative who will set up training with district techs and school system users prior to the school year, and will be in direct communication with all individuals involved throughout the school year
- iii) ID Card Printer and required equipment typically including Evolis one-sided, color

ID card printer, a webcam, two ribbons (300 card capacity), 600 30mil CR80 cards, printer driver software (Evolis Print Center), proprietary ID software (Windows compatible), a laptop set up with software (optional), a backdrop for photos similar to that of the yearbook (optional), and resupply pricing at cost, along with remote or onsite maintenance and support, resolutions to any issues within 24-48 hours, and loaner equipment if needed

g. Yearbook Services

i) Yearbook Photography Service Trips, each up to four hours in duration, to photograph requested clubs and groups, plays, sports game coverage, and athletic or classroom candid events, with appointments scheduled to coordinate photographing multiple events within one four hour trip to maximize coverage, by photographers trained and expected to apply the same level of professional photography to your game coverage as they apply at IHSA/WIAA state finals competitions, with digital images of all covered events accessible to the yearbook staff in the VIP Portal, and posted online at under "Student Activities and Game Coverage" for families and students to view and order in galleries secured with a password at school's request

Scheduling, data, and technical support, such as photo date requests and any information (data, parent/guardian emails, sports rosters, etc.) required to provide photography/ID services, well in advance of corresponding dates and formatted properly as directed by VIP, as well as technical support to assist with Administrator Credentials for software installs, and if the School owns their own ID printer.
 - **d.** Parent/Guardian Emails and Communication assistance with families/students regarding photography services, by providing parent/guardian email addresses to VIP, and by using provided informational text, links and digital flyers to post and share alerts and reminders in newsletters, using social media/email, on your website, etc.
 - e. Written (emailed) approval of any required proofs (ie. class composites, banners, posters, etc.) within seven business days in order to meet any outlined or expected delivery deadlines

8) Additional Conditions and Policies:

- a. VIP offers a 100% money back guarantee (does not apply to our non-refundable digital download orders), a replacement print, or a photo retake if a customer is not completely satisfied with portraits or products.
- b. Customers (students, staff, family members. event attendees, etc.) will be under no obligation to purchase.
- c. All orders will be placed after photo day and will be delivered directly to the address provided by the customer, with a direct-delivery fee added when the order is placed of \$5.95 for shipping and handling added to all school portrait orders less than \$25.00
- d. All images stored indefinitely. For best pricing, families are encouraged to order fall school portraits before January 1st. School portrait package prices increase 10% rounded up to the nearest dollar at this time of year to encourage early participation, and to maximize the value of fall quantity prices and any spring portraits offered
- e. All images are property of Visual Image Photography, Inc., are copyright protected, and are solely for the use of sale by VIP, publishing yearbooks, or authorized promotional purposes with VIP's prior written consent. Permission is not granted to make copies for sale, or other distribution in any manner that circumvents the sale of these images by VIP. The School will inform VIP of any image use in relation to this policy.
- f. The School/Athletic Department agrees to provide photo credit to Visual Image Photography when images are used in authorized print and electronic mediums. Any images used on social media should be the web download size from the VIP Portal. Any group images, state finals, and sports team images will be watermarked with a VIP logo provided by VIP.

- g. VIP will be the exclusive provider of any contracted photography services not described as "optional" herein. The School/Athletic Department will inform VIP of any variation in relation to this, and under certain circumstances to be determined by VIP, VIP may provide written confirmation approving an exception.
- h. VIP will be the exclusive provider of any product using VIP image/s which VIP is able to produce (such as prints, plaques, banners, posters, etc.). When VIP cannot produce the product or under certain circumstances to be determined by VIP, VIP may provide the required limited image release form and may charge an image fee.
- i. A specific number of yearbook service trips (non-revenue generating events before or on photo day) has been calculated to meet the normal needs of the School/Athletic Department, and VIP can be flexible in accommodating varying School needs. Upon request or under appropriate circumstances, VIP does retain the right to charge for trips in excess of the number stated herein at an additional \$125.00 per photographer for the first hour from the scheduled start time and \$30.00 per each additional hour, based on time spent at the event. VIP will notify the School of its intention to exercise that right in advance.
- j. Additional administrative products may be requested at a preferred-customer price (ie. extra sticker prints/principal's directories can be provided for \$25 per set/booklet, or \$15 per set/booklet when 5 or more are ordered)
- k. High School State Finals images are available to all partners of VIP upon request and are limited to what will be used for school display or in the yearbook publication and qualifying public relations outlets.
- I. Any prices specified are for the first year of the Agreement. VIP shall have the right to make minor adjustments to pricing in subsequent agreement years, by an amount not to exceed the increase in the "Consumer Price Index Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers Midwest Region All Items" since the commencement date of this Agreement or the last applicable increase, and Portrait Package Price increases for any renewal term shall not exceed the following: Existing Price, Maximum Increase; Less than \$15, \$1.00; Greater than \$15 and less than \$30, \$2.00; \$30 and over, \$3.00. Once adjusted, prices for any renewal term shall then be fixed for the duration of such renewal. VIP will alert the school of these changes.
- m. If access to students becomes unavailable, or within a school year school picture gross sales do not reach a minimum of \$2500.00 gross profit, the school agrees that complimentary services/products such as portrait photography, yearbook photography service trips, ID cards, etc. may also become limited, and VIP may issue an invoice for services or products already provided
- n. To the School, commission equal to 10% of the gross profit of fall underclass and senior "yearbook only" session package and print product net sales, only to the extent the gross profit from the underclass portrait event exceeds \$2500.00. For the purposes of this agreement, the term "gross profit" shall mean net receipts from an event (as defined in the following sentence) less 30% of net receipts for average refunds and production costs. Net receipts shall refer to total receipts from any individual photography event less any sales taxes included in the price of items sold. Amounts are calculated 21 days after images are made available for purchase, and checks are delivered to the school within 90 days.
- O. VIP agrees that the School/Athletic Department shall have the right, at its sole expense, to have a third party auditor audit the records of VIP to determine that any amounts paid to the School/Athletic Department have been correctly calculated. Any such auditor shall be an independent third party reasonably acceptable to VIP. Such audit shall be conducted at the offices of VIP at a mutually acceptable date. VIP agrees to use its best efforts to accommodate the auditor's convenience.

- p. The School / Athletic Department agrees to provide student data due two-three weeks prior to when IDs are needed / the first fall photo date, as follows: in either a Microsoft EXCEL compatible format or CSV file (pdf documents are not usable), with only one record per student/staff member, each piece of information in a separate column, and each column clearly labeled at the top of the sheet. All names need to be in their correct form regarding Capital and Lowercase letters (ie. Smith instead of SMITH). Parent/Guardian emails are required for the School to participate in VIP's Family Communication Plan. At least one of the following is required for verification purposes when families order online: parent/guardian email, phone number, street address, student ID #. Staff emails are required to receive complimentary digital downloads, and will only be used for this sole purpose. ID # number/bar code and grade are required to produce ID's. VIP will follow all Data and Email privacy policies herein.
- a. The School / Athletic Department agrees to provide a student data rosters due two-three weeks prior to the first fall photo date, as follows: in either a Microsoft EXCEL compatible format or CSV file (pdf documents are not usable), with only one record per student/staff member, each piece of information in a separate column, and each column clearly labeled at the top of the sheet. All names need to be in their correct form regarding Capital and Lowercase letters (ie. Smith instead of SMITH). Parent/Guardian emails are required to keep team galleries secure and for the School to participate in VIP's Family Communication Plan. Coach/Staff emails are also required for alerts to be sent when team images are posted, and will only be used for this sole purpose. VIP will follow all Data and Email privacy policies herein.
- q. To ensure student confidentiality, VIP shall comply with all applicable State and federal laws and regulations, including without limitation those regarding copyright, student records, and student confidentiality, including FERPA, the Illinois Student Records Act, and the Illinois Personnel Records Act. All personally identifiable information and data relating to School's/Athletic Department's students, parent-customers, and/or employees in conjunction with the VIP service and VIP materials shall at all times be treated as confidential by VIP and will not be copied, used or disclosed by VIP for any purpose except as authorized by this Agreement. VIP recognizes that personally identifiable information is protected against disclosure by federal and state statutes and regulations, including without limitation FERPA, the Illinois Student Records Act and VIP agree to comply with said restrictions. VIP shall indemnify and hold the School/Athletic Department harmless for any claims made against the School/Athletic Department for violation of this provision caused by VIP's negligence or willful misconduct.
- r. VIP ensures the security of data and images through password protection verification methods for both VIP employees and customers and by logging all image access. Under no circumstances will VIP display or share personal verification information used. Upon request, all online galleries, such as candid photos and club and group images posted for online view and purchase can also be password protected.
- s. Emails will at all times be treated as confidential by VIP and will not be shared with third parties, copied, used or disclosed for any purpose except as authorized. VIP treats emails as private data and emails are not shared with third parties. VIP only uses collected emails for identifying customers, responding to requests or inquiries to improve our service, and to communicate information relevant to the specific service provided and critical to the service's success. Customers are able to opt out of receiving any or all of communication from VIP by following the unsubscribe link/instructions provided in any email sent. Any school or association can make specific requests regarding email use.
- t. When subject identity can be determined VIP may obtain a model release from said subject to use in marketing materials such as but not limited to catalogs, fliers, and website design. Personal data such as name, school, email, etc. will never be used in the production of marketing materials

- except in regards to referrals and/or testimonials which are used only with the expressed written consent of subject.
- u. All VIP credit card transactions are processed through our secure merchant service provider, a reliable, established payment gateway, and no credit card numbers are saved
- v. VIP, at its sole cost, shall conduct background investigations of all its employees, agents, or others who will interact in proximity to the School's/Athletic Department's students, and, in accordance with Section 10-21.9 of the Illinois School Code, shall provide results of each background investigation to the School/Athletic Department, and shall comply with all requirements of Section 10-21.9 as may be amended from time to time. VIP shall not allow anyone to work under this Agreement whose criminal background check reveals items that would prohibit them from working with children under Illinois law or reveals other criminal convictions or other conduct which lawfully may be considered and which call into question such individual's fitness to work with children. In the event the Contractor fails to comply with the provisions of this Section and 105 ILCS 5/10-21.9, and as a result a suit or claim is instituted by a student for harm caused by an Employee or agent of the Contractor, then the Contractor agrees to fully defend and indemnify, including the reimbursement of attorney's fees and costs, the School/Athletic Department against any such claims.
- w. VIP understands and agrees that failure to fulfill obligations herein/contained in the corresponding proposal shall relieve the School/Athletic Department of obligation to the services described
- x. The School/Athletic Department understands and agrees that failure to fulfill obligations herein/contained in the corresponding proposal shall relieve VIP of the obligation to the services described
- y. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements and obligations
