## Early Childhood Special Education: Early On (0-3 years)

- HCISD uses the primary service provider model for delivering early intervention services (Early Childhood Special Education and Early On Services) to support families of infants and toddlers in achieving the outcomes documented in their individualized family service plan (IFSP). By using this model, we as a team of early intervention special education professionals can work together to provide assessment, intervention, consultation, and education to support children, as well as families. One member of our team, serving as the primary service provider (PSP), functions as the liaison between your family and the other team members. This ensures that a range of needs can be meant through team collaboration. Using an adult learning model, like coaching, the PSP interacts with and teaches the child and caregivers techniques that are designed to enhance the student & family's quality of life. Our goal at the HCISD is to help caregivers feel confident in their ability to support their children with increased knowledge and skills concerning a child's differences and to promote growth and development through natural learning opportunities. The goal is consistent with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part C.
- We are currently servicing 79 students & families: 34 Early On & 45 Early On/Special Education
- Since July 1st, we have received 52 Early On referrals, of which 40 are still within the processing stage.
- We provide a preschool transition playgroup 3 days/week. This service supports the successful transition of our youngest learners new to the school setting as preschoolers. The group runs Tuesday, Thursday, Friday from 9am to 10:30am at Greenfield School. The Playgroup offers an opportunity for children entering Preschool in the 20-21 school year to gain some exposure and experience to the school environment, routines, expectations and peer interactions.

- We are currently servicing 93 preschool students 3-5 years of age.
- We provide services in a variety of ways developed to meet each students individual needs as determined within the IEP meeting. Services may include Early Childhood Special Education Teacher services, Speech Services, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Social Work Services, and Paraprofessional support,

 We currently provide services to students within multiple locations including the child's home, local school district, HeadStart Classrooms, GSRP classrooms, Private Preschools, daycares and special education classrooms.
