

Consider approval of the purchase of Panorama Education

1. Background:

Southwest ISD utilizes a myriad of programs to identify and support students with at-risk academic, behavioral, and social-emotional needs. However, these programs are not compatible with the current PEIMS student information system (TEAMS) to allow for full integration in the development of monitoring and intervention student support plans.

Panorama Education is a program that allows for full integration with TEAMS, Imagine Learning, Eduphoria, and College Board, creating a complete student progress profile in academics, attendance, behavior, assessments, and social-emotional needs. This program will also support the tracking of credits at the secondary level and provides College Career Military Readiness data at the high school level. This customizable data will benefit teachers, counselors, social workers, administrators, and special needs support staff at both campus and district levels to for monitoring, supporting, and tracking the needs of at-risk students at all levels.

2. Process:

Panorama Education is an awarded District vendor for RFP #2223-121 for Student Educational Software from August 2024 - July 2025.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The cost of the Panorama Education RTI and SEL modules will be \$139,500. Both locally budgeted funds and State Compensatory Education (SCE) funds will be used to cover the cost of this district-wide program.

4. Recommendation:

The Board approves the purchase of Panorama Education for campus and District Staff to identify, monitor, and support SWISD at-risk students at a cost of \$139,500.00.
