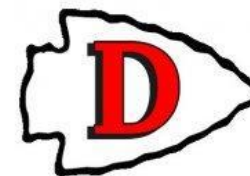

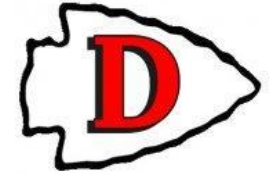

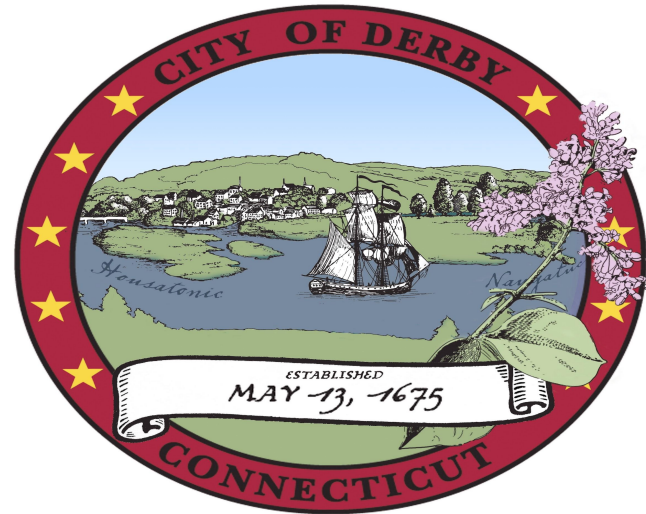




Culture & Climate
