Item Title: Approve the state waiver for Parent Notice Requirement for Students at Risk of Failure

Description:

Student Success Initiative (SSI) promotion/retention requirements found in the Texas Education Code (TEC), §28.0211 and based upon STAAR results are waived for the 2019–2020 school year. However, Texas school districts are still required to provide early notice to parents or guardians of students in grades 4 and 7 identified to be at risk of failure on the first administration of an assessment required for grade advancement in the next school year. Because South San ISD does not have sufficient information to make a determination about a student’s risk of failure based upon STAAR results at this time, the district is required to request a waiver to delay the notice requirement until the start of the 20-21 school year.

Historical Data:

This is the first time that the school district has had to submit the waiver due to COVID-19 school closures.
