Goal/Objective Addressed	Crosby ISD District Improvement Plan Goal #1: Crosby Independent School District will make academic achievement and student performance its priority.
Background	The ABS East School provides highly structured, behavioral interventions, counseling and special education programming for Crosby ISD special education students with behavioral and disruptive concerns that are beyond what is typical.
Staffing Implications	Approval of Harris County Department of Education ABS East Interlocal agreement poses no additional staffing implications for Crosby ISD.
Budget Information	Approval of the Harris County Department of Education ABS East interlocal agreement will allow access to the services and supports necessary to educate our Crosby ISD students who are exhibiting severe behavioral and disruptive concerns. The total estimated cost for the 2025 - 26 school year will be \$96,200.00. Each unit costs \$24,050.00. Cost is based on the PEIMS snapshot count from the prior year. The cost is covered through IDEA federal funds, as well as local funds.
Impact of this Action	Approval of this action will allow access to the services and supports necessary to educate our Crosby ISD special education students who exhibit severe behavioral and disruptive concerns.
