TELPAS Update

The State of Texas requires at least 95% completion for accountability purposes. Bastrop ISD has a completion rate of 99.7%. This would not have been possible without the dedicated and hard working Campus Testing Coordinators. The district will receive results in late May and results will be shared with families in early June.

This partnership will provide significant resources and opportunities for students and staff at these campuses. Proactive Planning for Student Success: The SPS Department is actively engaged in planning and developing resources to support the diverse needs of students, with a focus on effective transitions. Transitions include conducting data reviews and brief meetings for students who are transitioning from one campus to another (Elementary to Middle and Middle to High School). The brief meetings support students with more complex needs to ensure the receiving campus is ready to support the student.



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Evaluations: We continue our record breaking trends in the number of initial evaluations we've completed this school year. We anticipate completing at least 656 evaluations from August to June this school year versus 476 last year. The increase is attributed partially to the Dyslexia students who, by law, have to be tested for special education by the end of June.
