Transportation Department Update

Bodywork Repair in process to Bus #17 (May 20 incident)

Side scrape damage to perimeter trim over rear wheel well; fractured rivets on raised-ridge protective strips; damage to fuel cap door and fuel cap unit and damage to reflective decals Bus 17

Repair completed in-house to Bus #14 (April 9 deer collision incident; all repairs bolt-on parts). Damage to front bumper plus one mounting bracket; mangled license plate and tab sticker scraped off; fractured swing-out crossing arm.

Bus #10 Discharging (not maintaining battery charge); may require a thorough Diagnostic to either track a failing circuit (formerly called fuses in older buses) or a short somewhere in the electrical wiring system.
