

Current standing STAFF SURVEY RESULTS

- Lack of clear, consistent expectations across schools
- Student behavior & supervision challenges
- Belief that the pay doesn't reflect the extra workload or time commitment
- Work-life balance and family commitments
- "Spanish club threw a wrench in offerings" due to unintentional competition for students



Internal clarity & consistency ACROSS THE DISTRICT

- Flexibility on number of sessions taught
- Flexibility on days taught per session
- Options and examples of courses taught will be shared
- Clarity on daily rate ~\$46.00 (\$960 per session)
- Additional logistical support for supervision and dismissal
- Supervisor hired to help with parent pickup (those showing up late)



Jefferson clubs & intramurals POTENTIAL ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

- Allow sixth grade students to attend certain intramurals and afterschool clubs at Jefferson Junior High
- Limited space as current program numbers are high
- Due to driver/bus shortages, activity bus availability for elementary schools will be a challenge

EXPECTATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

- Must provide busing:
 - through internal programs running at the school, or
 - must pay for busing, current est. \$150.00 per day
- Scholarships to low income students (60/40 ratio)
 - Lottery for program entrance for scholarships
- Pay rental agreement for room usage
- Responsible for supervision until all students are picked up
