Subject: Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for the Flower Mound High School 20-Year Refresh Phase 1 project included in the 2017 Bond

Background Information:

- The Year Three 2017 Bond Projects have been assigned Architect and Construction Manager at Risk firms by the Board of Trustees.
- The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) process was presented to the Board in an Information Item at the February 12, 2018 Board meeting.
- The Flower Mound High School 20-Year Refresh Phase 1 project has been advertised and competitively bid to sub-contractors by Core Construction, the Construction Manager at Risk firm. The sub-contractor bids have been evaluated and scoped for this project. Core Construction has presented a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for this project.
- Core Construction has presented a total Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Flower Mound High School 20-Year Refresh Phase 1 project of \$32,000,031. The pricing presents the best value to the District.

Administrative Consideration:

- Funding for this project comes from the 2017 Bond funds.
- The procurement complies with Section 2269 of the Government Code.
