Follow Up to Questions from the February 8, 2017, Board of Trustees Retreat

Re: Number of Students Benefiting from SAFAC funds

Question:

At the Board Retreat on February 8, 2017, Trustee Raj Menon inquired about the number of students impacted by the awarding of SAFAC funds and the types of activities funded.

Answer:

Funds generated from Student Activity Fees are awarded to student organizations, organizations providing direct benefits to students, and to college departments hosting activities with direct benefit to students or in support of students. Funds are requested through one of two processes, 1) through a budget request process in April of the preceding fiscal year, and 2) through a monthly application process with requests for specific events awarded in an on-going basis.

At the April 2016 SAFAC budget hearings, twelve organizations and departments submitted requests in the amount of \$787,189.30 for the 2016-2017 budget year. All twelve organizations received funds with the total amount awarded \$648,738.00.
