Bids were received on December 9, 2015 for Bid Package T4. Bid Package T4 is for the acquisition of equipment and installation at the Thirteen (13) Community Rooms (multi-purpose) of the K-4 elementary buildings throughout the district.

#### **Bid Evaluation Summary and Recommendations**

After an extensive review of the bid proposals, a thorough post-bid interview was held with the low bidder to verify the proposal was inclusive of the scope of work, and gather information on related experience. The attached Bid Tabulation indicates the bids received, company name, and base bid.

Based upon the evaluation of the project team, we recommend that a contract be awarded to the following company. **This bid is within the bond budget allocated for this work.**

This category includes equipment and installation of audio visual equipment in the multi-purpose rooms of the thirteen K-4 elementary buildings. The buildings slated for the initial installs are Cleveland, Coolidge, Rosedale, Hayes, Kennedy, and Roosevelt. The buildings being renovated the summer of 2016, Grant, Hoover and Randolph, will be next. Buchanan, Cass, Garfield and Webster will be installed in 2017 following the construction schedule.

The equipment and installation is based upon the current installation at Cooper Upper Elementary and includes a high lumens Epson Projector, electronic display screen and control equipment housed in a lockable controls cabinet.
