Correspondence

- **Huntley Lawsuit** – We received a letter indicating that some schools who have not charged fees for the past six years have been dismissed from the case. We have shared the requested information from the last few years about student fees with the attorneys that are handling the matter.

Information/Updates

- **Athletic Stipend Meeting** – On August 9, Ty Shippen, Josh Aston, and I met with representatives from all of the different sports to discuss making adjustments to the activity stipends. We agreed that there would be three 'tiers' of coaching salaries:
 1. Head Varsity Coach;
 2. Assistant Varsity Coach(es), JV Coach, 9th Grade Coach
 3. Assistant JV and 9th Grade Coaches.

We also discussed creating a set number of bands to group sports with similar responsibilities and length of season. I have attached the comparison that was shared at the meeting. We will have more information after we meet with the coaches again on Friday September 14.

- **Staff/Building Visits:**

We held a successful Admin Retreat on August 7 and I met with all our new staff on August 9 at the New Employee Orientation. Both meetings were well organized and we received positive comments due to the efforts of our central office administrators.
