

Executive Summary: PRESS 122 First Reading

Introduction

PRESS, which stands for Policy Reference Education Subscription Service, is a policy service provided by the Illinois Association of School Boards (IASB). It provides school districts with an "encyclopedia" of sample board policies, administrative procedures, and exhibits. The board and district staff use these materials as a reference to help develop and update their own local policies.

Policies with Notable Changes

This is the first reading of the policy changes recommended in PRESS Issue 122. The following policies have important language changes and should be reviewed by the Board.

7:330 Student Use of Buildings - Equal Access	Has been rewritten to address the need for more guidance under the Equal Access Act	Approve as presented
