General Impressions from the Focus Groups and Survey

The Lakeview School District continues to be known for a focus on academics and for providing students with a quality education. They are an educational leader that supports innovation among their teaching staff. In addition to a strong administrative team and a caring, helpful teaching staff, the community is widely recognized as a strong supporter of students and their education.

A welcoming environment and communication with the community are two areas that the Lakeview School District excels in. Parent and family involvement is strong and teachers have high expectations for students. Students report that they appreciate their teachers and other staff for their roles in making Lakeview a caring and positive place for students. Being able to earn college credit and having a variety of course offerings were frequently mentioned as being both important and effective. Opportunities to participate in music were cited as highly effective, as were athletic opportunities. Students and parents appreciate that Lakeview has a variety of high-quality extracurricular activities including music, athletics, fine arts, robotics, trap, math team, and mock trial. Live streaming of events was mentioned as a huge positive.

Lakeview is a welcoming school that is committed to a positive atmosphere for both students and staff. Lakeview was frequently described as a "family". The school building and the sports complex facilities were frequently referred to with pride. Having all students, pre-K through 12th grade is considered both unique and positive. The interactions between older and younger students are seen as positive.

The Lakeview School District has a strong commitment to continuous improvement. Teachers continue to look for ways to increase student learning. They are supported by an administration that is highly supportive to trying innovative strategies and to taking risks.

E-learning was an area of interest for the Lakeview School Board. Results showed that the teacher made a huge difference in the effectiveness of the e-learning day.

Areas for improvement would be:

- bullying prevention,
- additional Mental Health counseling opportunities for students,
- additional Mental Health counseling opportunities for students,
- fair and equitable treatment of all students, and
- respect by students for other students and for teachers.
