Mrs. Campbell explained to the team that even though the composite scores looked similar, there was growth going on within the each group especially in their priority focus areas for each grade level and for the kids being progressed monitored. She also told the team that K, 1, and 2 are scored on different measures from the beginning of the year until the mid-year testing and this affects the composite score. The key is to observe the growth from mid-year until the end of the year assessment and understand this is one assessment measure and it should be reviewed with other assessments to get a complete picture of individuals.

b. Boys and Girls update (Jenna Larkin via email)

- We now are offering free club membership to ALL teens in the sixth grade and up (this is for all three clubs). They MUST be sixth grade and fill out a membership registration packet. Sports are different, they still have to pay all sports fees.
- Currently we are trying to boost our teen and overall daily attendance. Our average daily attendance (ADA) has been down from last year this time due to many different factors; illnesses, fee increases and enforced, etc. This time last year ADA was 120+, currently we see 77-80.
- We have several programs that are run daily for members to participate in; Power Hour (one-on-one homework help), Healthy Habits (good eating habits), Good News Club, Positive Actions (leaning that there are different ways to handle different situations and learning more about one's self), Triple Play (hour of play, rec games), art, STEAM, Boys Scouts will be coming soon. Those are just a few that are offered. It depends on the time of year as to what we offer. All of these programs are geared towards elementary and teens.
