It is not the policy of ECISD to award contracts based solely on "low bid/proposal". *The following criteria are used by ECISD to evaluate the overall "best value":

- 1. The purchase price; 40 pts
- 2. The reputation of the vendor's goods or services; 20 pts
- 3. The quality of the vendor's goods or services; 20 pts
- 4. The extent to which the goods or services meet the district's needs; 10 pts
- 5. The vendor's past relationship with the district; 2 pts
- 6. The impact on the ability of the district to comply with the laws and rules relating to historically under-utilized businesses; 1pt
- The total long-term cost to the district to acquire the vendor's goods and services; 1pt;
- 8. Any other relevant factor specifically listed in this RFP; 1pt.
