Re: Purchase of Road Salt

I would like to gain approval for the purchase of 1,700 tons of road salt for the 2022-23 winter season at a cost of \$53.45 per ton for a total cost of \$90,865.00 from Detroit Salt Company via the MiDEAL Purchase Consortium. This is an increase of \$9.87 per ton from last year.

The bulk road salt purchased for the last three winter seasons is listed below:

2019-20: Purchased 1,700 tons and used 1,500 tons

2020-21: Purchased 1,500 tons and used 1,300 tons

2021-22: Purchased 1,300 tons and used 1,130 tons
