Cost Share: When the cost of a service is equally shared among the participating districts.

Direct Service Budget: In cases where a service is not established or a bulk number of days is purchased, the CESA 9 business office will calculate a Direct Service Budget which takes into account specific or unique costs attributed to the work.

Subcontracted: When services are fulfilled by a partner organization or consultant, the actual cost to CESA 9 is determined by the partner organization or consultant. A 3% service fee is added to offset CESA 9 administrative costs.
