## **Background Information**

Per CH (Local), the Board delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to make budgeted purchases for goods or services. However, any single, budgeted purchase of goods or services that costs \$50,000 or more, regardless of whether the goods or services are competitively purchased, shall require Board approval before a transaction may take place.

Edugence will offer district and campus personnel access to an intuitive dashboard designed for efficient data tracking and monitoring. This tool will provide in-depth data analysis for assessments at both the campus and district levels, facilitate curriculum management, and track professional learning activities. Additionally, it will support T-TESS/T-PESS evaluations, ensure compliance with Emergent Bilingual Language Proficiency Assessment Committee (LPAC) requirements, and provide tracking for College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR), attendance, and student discipline. Edugence proposes to support the successful design, implementation, and optimization of the Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA) system. Their integrated platform and expert services aim to:

- Ensure accurate and defensible TIA teacher designations through seamless data integration and validation.
- Provide district leaders with real-time analytics to support informed personnel decisions.
- Build internal capacity to sustain and scale TIA implementation district-wide.
