BACKGROUND

Each summer, Beaverton School District provides learning opportunities through multiple summer programs for targeted groups of students. Sessions offer both academic and enrichment opportunities.

In 2025, BSD summer programs served 3,675 students, from incoming kindergarten through age 21. These programs included:

- Elementary Program
- Middle School Program
- High School Program
- Extended School Year (ESY) Program
- Newcomer Program
- Migrant Education
- Native LifeWays Camp
