Grant Programs

- ESSA grant application (Title programs) is complete and submitted to T.E.A.
 - T.E.A. released a "To the Administrator Addressed" letter on 7/3/2025 detailing which funds the Federal Department of Education is reviewing at this time. It is unknown what will become of these funds that have already been allocated to Hallsville ISD for the FY26. This could affect budgets within the following grants:
 - Title I, Part C Migrant Education, \$10,050
 - Title II, Part A Supporting Effective Instruction, \$883,526
 - Title III, Part A English Language Acquisition, \$231,138
 - Title III, Part A Immigrant, \$4,615
 - Title IV, Part A Student Support and Academic Enrichment, \$342,986
