SUBJECT: New Equipment Storage Buildings at 6 Schools

We need to have Six (6) new Outside Equipment Storage Buildings erected at the following schools: Cass, Cleveland, Hoover, Kennedy, Perrinville, and Rosedale. We have a quote for six (6) Easi-Set Precast Concrete Buildings. These buildings would be 12'-6" X 12'-6" by 8'-8" high. The quote is for \$13,300.00 each and we would still have to pour foundations and a slab up to the doors at an additional cost of approximately \$1,500.00 each for a total of \$14,800.00 for each shed. Total cost for buildings is approximately \$88,800.00.

If we have the same size buildings constructed on site the estimated cost will be approximately \$10,500.00 each. These buildings would be with concrete foundations, cement block walls, and conventional wood rafters with standing seam metal roofs. Total cost for buildings is approximately \$63,000.00.

Both of these projects would require Architect drawings and State of Michigan approval and then sent out to bid.
