COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER: FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- Work to ensure increased, systematic use of the CCC throughout grades 9-12
- Implement a workshop model to provide choice and access
 - Examples: Resume writing, NAVIANCE 101, Exploring Military Options, Entering the Job Force, Maneuvering the Common Application, Scholarship Sources
 - Small group guided instruction thru Post-Secondary Planning Process
- Collaborate with the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Coordinator to increase internships, job shadow experiences, career related field trips.
- Increase support for the needs of Choice students in the post-secondary planning process

NAVIANCE

GMMS

- Currently used in Grade 8.
- Cluster Finder
- Use of other online resources for developmental guidance lessons such as an electronic learning style inventory

GMHS

- Used in grades 9-12
- Full integration of Naviance for resume writing, career inventory, interest inventory, college search, career and labor market information.
- College application materials such as the teacher and counselor recommendation and official transcript electronically sent out to colleges using Naviance.
