TITLE: Approval of Out of State Travel

BACKGROUND:

STUDENTS

Bill Lang, Kathy Franklin, Ashleigh Houlton, Chelsea Crane, and Cheryl Wojdyla from Ironwood Ridge High School request permission to take 18 students from the Women's Volleyball Team to Las Vegas, Nevada, September 14-17, 2017. Approximate cost of the travel is \$5,748 and will be paid for by tax credit donations and student activity funds. One school day will be missed and substitutes are not required.

Mary Dickson, AJ Lepore, Dawn Lepore, Debbie Dickson, Mark Pincus, Maricel Peterson, Caryn Tate, Christine Fapp, and Amy Blankenship from Ironwood Ridge High School request permission to take 27 students from Drama, Musical, and Tech Theatre Club to New York City, New York, March 19-24, 2018. Approximate cost of the travel is \$50,625 and will be paid for by tax credit donations and student activity funds. No school days will be missed.

Tassi Call from the District Offices requests permission to attend the AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) District Leadership Conference in Denver, Colorado, September 26-29, 2017. Approximate cost of the travel is \$1,719 and will be paid for by federal funds designated for staff development. Four school days will be missed.

EdLeader21 is the nation's first professional learning community dedicated to helping district leaders focus their work on the integration of the 4Cs (critical thinking, communication, collaboration and creativity) into education. This year's annual event will pay special focus to the exciting new project, Profile of a Graduate (POG) which seeks to energize communities of educators, students and parents around a 21st century definition of student success. Through the POG project, EdLeader21 is able to provide schools and districts with the tools and resources needed to support in the development and implementation of the POG.

This conference will provide important information for us as we prepare to define the profile of the 21st century graduate, and to evaluate where we are as a district in our efforts to achieve this vision for every Amphitheater School District student. This work will also prepare us for our future AdvancED accreditation evaluation and Superintendent Jaeger's strategic plan.

Roseanne Lopez, Michael Bejarano, Tassi Call, Amanda Magelli, Chris Trimble, Tara Bulleigh, JJ Letts, Glenda Arffa, Jason Weaver, Laurie Sheber, Julie Valenzuela, and Terri Amonson request permission to attend the EdLeader21 Annual Conference in Atlanta, GA, October 2-5, 2017. Approximate cost of travel is \$23,542.75 and will be paid for by federal funds designated for staff development.

The Superintendent requests permission to attend the RTM Education Congress to be held in Orlando, Florida, October 7-11, 2017. Approximate cost of the travel, after a significant partial scholarship for the event, is



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\$1,325. The District's portion of the travel costs will be paid from the Superintendent Office maintenance and operation budget. Two and one-half work days will be missed, and a substitute is not applicable.
