5. Gradebook Guidelines

- In an effort to improve communication with parents and establish more consistent grade book appearance next year, the high school will be utilizing category grades for all staff.
 - i. Three categories will be used:
 - 1. Performance this is where you will find all tests, projects, papers and other assessments of student learning.
 - 2. Practice this is where you will find homework and quizzes
 - 3. Effort Student participation, group work, and other learning habits that are important for students to have will be included in this category.
 - ii. All assignments that were previously included in the gradebook will continue to be included just organized differently

- iii. All teachers will use a common 100 point scale for assigning letter grades as well
- Grading procedures and policies will be included in all course syllabuses and all syllabuses will be posted online
