Background Information

As of April 2024, **331** out of district (interdistrict) transfer students were enrolled in MISD as follows:

The students meet qualifying criteria including attendance, grades, behavior, state assessment scores, and payment of transfer fees when applicable.

Fiscal implications

- The minimum approximate revenue per ADA is \$6160, in addition to the modest revenues generated from tuition.
- During the 2024-2025 school year, 497 students transferred out of Midway ISD to surrounding school districts. This record is included for reference.

Administration Recommendation

The administration recommends the acceptance of out of district (interdistrict) transfer students to balance the number of students who are transferring out of Midway ISD to surrounding school districts. FDA (LOCAL) states that the Board shall annually determine the tuition fee for interdistrict transfer students. The administration recommends keeping the existing tuition fee of \$500 each semester, plus a \$20 transaction fee each semester through the district payment system, *My School Bucks*.
