Response Rate

- In 2016, 296 8th grade students participated in the Illinois Youth Survey
- This represents 49% of enrolled 8th grade students
- Since this is less than 50% of the grade level, IYS recommends that we **use caution** when interpreting these results, or comparing them to prior years, as this data may or may not be representative of the total student population
 - NOTE: 2012 and 2014 had a 77% response rate for 8th grade students






Substance Use Rates Over Time – Any Substance

Use of Any Substance in the Past Year 8th Grade




Substance Use Rates Over Time – By Substance

Bullying Victimization in the Past 12 Months




Bullying Experiences Over Time – By Type
