- Taught in a way that put students in a later life position for over average income
- Taught our generation to pass down and teach younger generations same skills

Worked to develop not only automotive skills, but also to develop well-adjusted young people outside the classroom environment

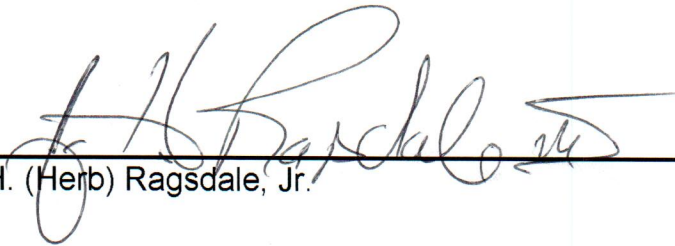

Name the currently un-named auto mechanics building "The Dusty Moore Vocational Building"


- Naming the building will honor the legacy of Dusty Moore
