Plumbing Program of Study

- Responds to Regional labor market needs for licensed tradespeople.
- Offers students an opportunity to NCCER Core and Plumbing Level 1 certifications
- Aligns with local apprenticeship, community college programs and local trade school – Fort Worth Pipe Trades Training Center

Implementation Plan

Courses offered: *Plumbing Technology:* Principles of Construction, Plumbing Technology I & II, Practicum in Construction.

Grade levels: 9-12

Campuses: Brewer High School

Partnerships: Local industry partnerships, workforce boards, TCC, Fort Worth Pipe Trades Training Center

Facilities/Resources: Utilize existing CTE labs, shop space with minor modifications

Certifications: NCCER Plumbing Level I, NCCER Core

Estimated Costs: 1st year \$5K-\$7K curriculum, equipment, tools.
