LOCAL DESIGNATION SYSTEM APPROVAL

1. Application Submission to TEA

- Districts submit an application to TEA
- Outlining their local designation system
- TEA reviews and accepts or denies the application

2. Data Validation

- Districts submit teacher performance data and proposed designations to Texas Tech University
- TEA issues final system approval and awards designations


