BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- In 2009, the Texas Legislature's House Bill 3 directed the Texas Comptroller's office to "identify school districts and campuses that use resource allocation practices that contribute to high academic achievement and cost-effective operations".
- In response to this directive, the Comptroller's office released the Financial Allocation Study for Texas (FAST) in December 2010.
- Each Texas school district is assigned a FAST rating of one (1) to five (5) stars that indicates its success in combining cost-effective spending with the achievement of measurable student academic progress.
- Five stars is the best or highest rating and reflects the strongest relative academic progress combined with the lowest relative spending.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS:

- The Aledo ISD fared very well in this study and received a FAST rating of 4.5 stars.










