District Costs	Jackie	In 2021-22, the district pays \$139/credit for online courses and \$224/credit for in-person courses.
Enrollment Process	Vanessa	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Meet with RWHS counselor to discuss why PSEO may be a good fit.</li><li>2) RWHS counselor provides PSEO advisory contact and application information. Counselor will assist with this process if student requests.</li><li>3) Student completes MDE form &amp; PSEO Contract and returns it to RWHS counselor.</li><li>4) Counselor sends completed MDE form/transcript to PSEO institution</li><li>5) Student attends orientation at PSEO institution (SE) and registers for classes with PSEO advisor at SE.</li><li>6) Student meets with RWHS counselor to review graduation progress and adjust RWHS schedule accordingly. These meetings occur in August when our master schedule is set and schedules are completed. For those registering for Spring classes, students meet with their</li></ol>

		counselor in November to adjust 2nd semester RWHS schedules and review transcripts.
Minimum age or grade for someone to enroll	Vanessa	<p>Students are allowed to register for 1 CTE class in 10th grade, pending they meet requirements.</p> <p>Beginning Junior/Senior year, they are eligible for additional general education courses, pending they meet requirements.</p>
Do parents sign any contract?	Vanessa	<p>Yes, there is a contract...I will share it with you.</p> <p>Unfortunately, with COVID/distance learning and counselor changes...this has been difficult to get back.</p>
How are students communicated with if they choose not to attend after they sign up?	Vanessa	<p>We do not change RWHS schedules (add in PSEO) until they have registered with their PSEO advisor. Students then communicate with the counselors by sharing their PSEO Schedule. If they choose not to attend PSEO classes, they would need to communicate with their PSEO advisor and withdraw on their D2L account. This is gone over with each student at the PSEO Orientation at SE.</p>
What is the district's cost if a student withdraws?	Jackie	<p>If a student withdraws before a specified deadline, the district does not pay for the credits.</p> <p>If a student withdraws after the deadline, the district pays for the credits in full.</p>
