2022-23 Open Enrollment Period Begins Soon

What is Open Enrollment?

The inter-district public school open enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend public school in a school district other than the one in which they reside.

Who can apply?

Any Wisconsin resident in 4K to grade 12 may apply to attend a nonresident school district under the open enrollment program. However, a child may transfer to a nonresident school district for early childhood education or 4K only if the child's resident school district offers the same type of program and only if the child is eligible for that program in the resident school district.

When can parents apply?

The regular open enrollment application period for the 2022-23 school year begins on February 7, 2022, and ends at 4:00 pm on April 29, 2022. The best way to apply is online (a link to the online application is at the top of this page during the application period). Safe Routes to School

Thank you to the Town of West Sweden Board and Frederic Village Board for their desire to work with the District to expand our Safe Routes to School programming. I recently spoke at both meetings and they expressed excitement about partnering with the District to explore opportunities to add a paved path between the school buildings. This would create a safer route of travel for students and community members.

Homeless Student Grant

The three year DPI homeless grant awarded to the District in 2021-22 will allow the District to hire one or more staff members to work specifically with our homeless youth and families. Between the state grant, and an additional federal grant, money will be available to specifically serve our students through 2024.

WI Reading Corp

Ms. O'Connor (Reading Specialist) has been investigating an opportunity for the District to partner with WI Reading Corp to better serve our students' literacy needs. The program provides tutors that will work directly with our students to develop literacy skills and strategies. An application process is required.
