
Net Budget Impact:

- 2. Install Additional Stone Along North Area to Raise Existing Grade Elevation
- 3. Fine Grade and Compact Aggregate Base for Stability and Proper Drainage
- 4. Apply Prime Coat @ .2 Gal/SY (Diluted SS-1)
- 5. Install and Compact 2" Bit. Binder (Modified)
- 6. Install and Compact 2" Bit. Surface (Modified)
- 7. Stripe New Asphalt Per Existing Layout
