

SUBJECT:	Consideration and possible approval of the Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) for Tegeler Community School.
BACKGROUND:	Tegeler Community School is a PISD Dropout Prevention and Recovery Program authorized under the Texas Education Code (TEC), §29.0822 and Texas Administrative Code (TAC), §129.1027 which provides flexible hours and days of attendance for students who meet the TEC criteria of a student who is at risk of dropping out of school. The goal of the program is to improve graduation rates for students who are in danger of dropping out of school, have dropped out, or who are behind in credits and testing requirements.
FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:	A student may earn minutes of attendance in both classes held during the regular school day and evening. Instruction time for the OFSDP is funded at the same rate under the FSP formulas as attendance for ADA in the traditional program.
RECOMMENDATION:	We recommend approval of the Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) for Tegeler Community School.
