Basic Information:

West Chicago Elementary School District 33 received grant money aimed at filling teacher vacancies and improving retention rates. As part of these efforts, District 33 would like to partner with a company called Access to provide employees with discounts at a multitude of places.

Background/Historical Context:

As districts across the state navigate the continuing teacher shortage, retention is of high value. District 33 would like to show their appreciation to staff by purchasing a subscription to Access, the largest private employee discount network in North America. With over 40 years in business, Access provides an average savings of \$1,500-\$2,500 annually per employee and up to 50% off savings at local merchants. Access also provides:

- 1. Branding for web, email, and mobile: Each time a staff member goes into their account, the District 33 logo will appear, supporting loyalty to the district.
- 2. Mobile: iPhone and Android apps for show-your-phone savings
- 3. Travel: The travel booking engine routinely saves 30%-70% of the rates of other travel discount sites
- 4. Email: Twice per month, Access Perks will send an email to employees showcasing new and exciting discounts
- 5. Support: Included is full technical and offer/redemption support available direct to employees from Access staff

The cost is tiered based on number of employees and Access has waived the one time setup fee for District 33. The annual cost is \$7,932. The service order can be found here.
